

What a most wondrous and joyous experience we had in Haiti this past week! God called nine of us together as we ministered in 4 villages on La Gonave Isle. I want to thank you for your prayers and generous support in helping us get there – we could not have done this without God's help and the support of friends, family and the body of Christ. For those who ordered pizza, ham sandwiches, ribs or chicken, or just gave financially, I say "thank you" as together we were able to do great things in Jesus' name!

The medical team (Mac, Charles, Clotaire, Kevin, Shirley, Diane, Jenny) saw over 750 patients and the construction team (PC and Greg) worked on decaying walls in two churches, started construction on a three room Sunday school wing and spent several days working on the air strip. Greg and I met with 35 pastors and lay leaders for a teaching on "Returning to the Basics of Pastoral Care". Diane and Shirley had their annual training with 55 teachers from all over the region. I also preached (Clotaire translated) on Sunday morning and gave an evangelistic message at an outdoor evening service. We also provided scholarships for 12 students, purchased and fitted a wheelchair for a disabled man, installed metal doors on a home, gave financial gifts to 18 teachers in Gros Mangles, provided a ticket for our translator to attend school in the DR, employed over 150 workers during the week, and collectively demonstrated hundreds of "random acts of kindness".

God was/is so good and faithful as he kept special watch over us and we felt his favor as we traveled and ministered in his Son's name. Jesus! Sweetest name I know. I pray that he will continue to use us each day as we purpose to put our hope and trust in Him alone!

Tentatively, it looks like the team will be sharing their experiences, pictures and videos during a combined service on *Sunday, March 11* at 10am (There will be no Sunday school, traditional service, contemporary service, Kid's church. 

Counting blessings

Every so often, sometimes during a quiet time, my mind drifts back to earlier times when influential events or people provided positive direction for my life. I'm quite sure many of these have long since retired to the far recesses of my brain, but fortunately I can still remember several even if some details have disappeared. Usually I don't dwell too much on the past, however, in the spirit of "counting my blessings", it seems beneficial to occasionally think back to how God has blessed me and guided my path over the years.

Recalling these events and people remind me of my life's walk and how God has directed it over the years. They have led me along the "narrow" path and brought me back to it when I strayed from it. I thought I would share a few with you in the hopes it might help you recall some blessings you have received.

No list would be complete without mentioning my parents and the home I grew up in. Without getting into specifics, suffice it to say there was love, hard work, and integrity. School work was important, and so was going to church and Sunday School. For parents that grew up during the Great Depression, practical management of finances was important, including ensuring their kids had the resources to go to college.

I owe a lot of my Christian background, training, and spiritual growth to our pastor. He was pastor at our church from 1950 to 1990, long enough to shepherd me from kindergarten thru and beyond college, to baptize me (and Brenda), and to marry us. He believed the <u>whole</u> Bible is foundational (see 2 Timothy 3:16-17) and that it is essential to live by it. I remember one of his favorite verses was Psalm 119:11 "Your word have I hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You." (NKJV). For him, every interaction was an opportunity to teach and impart life lessons.

There were also many great Christian examples at church growing up. Sunday School teachers, deacons and other leaders, friends of parents, and others. These examples are important to watchful young folks soaking it all up. One Junior High Sunday School teacher has stuck in my memory over the years. He loved young people and it was evident in the way he taught and interacted with the class. Interestingly, when I came back to the area and church after college graduation and began to get involved in church service, I found myself serving with many of these great examples. They were also great mentors, accepting me as "one of them". It was interesting learning to call them by their first name after so many years of Mr. or Mrs.

There was the mountain top (or better described, above the clouds) experience during a 1970's flight back from California. It was a time of renewal and commitment as God was "right there with me". And what about getting married? And having three little ones calling you "Daddy"? Can't be beat!


Perhaps one of the greatest blessings from God is His promise to forgive us our sins: "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9 NKJV). Certainly I don't deserve it. Thankfully He loves me enough to do it.

Also, many blessings have come after mistakes or difficult experiences that God either allowed, or that resulted from poor choices. I've learned that if I keep my eyes on Him, I come out on the other side stronger and more secure in Him, and truly blessed. It's helpful to picture myself on my knees before Him, for, as James says: "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up." (James 4:10 NKJV).
